

Submit your Objection

How to Object — Step by Step

1. Go to the Harborough planning portal
Visit: pa2.harborough.gov.uk/online-applications

2. Search the application
Type this reference into the search box:

26/00480/OUT

Leave status as
“All”

3. Open the application
When the application appears, click into it.

4. Click “Comments”
Look for the Comments button.

Then click:

“Login and make a comment”

You may need to register or sign in first.

5. Write your objection
Use your own words. You can mention concerns such as:

- Flooding
- Sewage capacity
- Surface water drainage
- Traffic and highway safety
- School and GP capacity
- Lack of infrastructure
- Impact on Broughton Astley Brook and Narborough Bog SSSI
- Cumulative impact of multiple developments

6. Submit before the deadline
The deadline is 23/05/2026

Important: sending photos or videos

The portal does not allow photos or videos to be uploaded with your comment.
